

### **Conditions of Entry**

- 1 All Entries to be printed on entry form enclosed or downloaded on website.
- 2 Entry forms must be completed and signed personally by exhibitor who will agree to comply with the rules of the show.
- 3 Entry fees must accompany entry form otherwise entries will not be accepted.
- 4 All entries must be fully registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of NZ in either the Purebred Stud Book or the Partbred Register, and in the case of foals, be eligible for registration.
- 5 All Stallions and Colts must be supervised at all times. (refer condition 8)
- 6 All foals to be restrained or secure at all times, and must be at least 3 weeks old.
- In all classes where applicable the name of the pony, age, colour, dam, sire and stud book no. shall be given on the entry form. Those Stallions and Geldings over the age of three years with temporary numbers will not be eligible for entry. Ponies registered as geldings must be gelded. Stallions must be registered and DNA'd & not on colt papers.
- 8 All colts & stallions over 2yrs must wear a bit and must be handled by person 16yrs or over.
- 9 When an animal has duly been entered and catalogued in any class the substitution of another animal will not be permitted.
- 10 Judging will commence at 9.00am unless otherwise stated. Entrants not present for judging at the commencement of the class will not be admitted.
- 11 The Judges decision will be final.
- 12 The committee at it's absolute discretion may refuse an entry or cancel an entry already accepted or decline to admit to the grounds or remove any animal or exhibitor from the grounds.
- 13 The committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be caused to or inflicted by any animal, person or property.
- 14 The committee reserves the right to make any alteration to the program or postpone or cancel the show as it sees fit.
- 15 The committee reserves the right to amalgamate or divide any classes where necessary.
- 16 Purebred ponies must not be plaited.
- 17 75% of entry fee will be refunded on the presentation of a vet or doctors certificate.
- 18 Dogs must be on leads except when in truck park, but must be in control at all times. No dogs in Landcorp at anytime.
- 19 Goodie Bags are for those that have entered before closing date and that they turn up with their entries on the day.

Breast Plate Numbers are preferred.

If you haven't got one we can supply an armband number.
